

Everything seems to be moving slow, but we only want it moving as fast as the Lord wants it. We are trusting that He will build this church. We began supporting our first missionary in December. A group of 3 from a Bible college in Mexico was with us on a Sunday night. It was a blessing to have them with us. We are hoping to have one of their big groups come help our church for a couple of weeks next year. We were hoping to get them here this year, but we were told they are already booked. It would require us to pay high fees or return to the states and start the process over.
